Dear residents and staff of WNRC. I am writing to provide you with an update on Covid-19. As it stands, we have had two residents test positive with Covid-19 on 1/16/22. While we believe this to be an isolated incident, we are taking precautions to prevent Covid-19 from infecting others here at WNRC. We ask all residents and staff to report any new issues with shortness of breath, elevated temperature, and cough to the charge nurse or the Director of Nursing. At this time, we are prepared to take care of all residents who believe they may have signs and symptoms of Covid-19.

WNRC is taking Covid-19 seriously. Please know that the best way to prevent the spread of Covid-19 is by washing your hands, covering your cough, and using hand sanitizer before touching yourself or someone else. Our staff has been instructed to use a mask & a face shield while providing care to limit the risk of transmitting Covid-19. We ask patients who leave their rooms to put on a mask for their protection.

I understand that this is a challenging time, but please know we are all going through this together. WNRC has strong residents and staff who have weathered difficult situations in the past. As a team, we can work to
